



The sketches at the front cover come from a collection of a visionary, late member of our Society.



## *Teaching 19th*

## *Teaching 32nd*

Co-ordination means controlled energy in every direction. This energy, however, moves in harmony with the pulse of the natural life.

It is possible for man to co-ordinate his actions with the guidance of the Divinity, so that he is in harmony both with himself and with his brothers. But the difficulty arises when co-ordination takes place on a large scale; that is to say, when a Principle seeks to co-ordinate a Nation whose intellect is not always obedient towards it. Under such circumstances co-ordination has no harmony. If it sustained by means of words, it is through necessity. This kind of co-ordination is not productive, despite the measures taken by the Principle.

Yet why have many experts rejected co-ordination as unprofitable? This happens because the inexperienced Principle, urged on by the Spirit of Evil, operates in an unsuitable manner and thereby creates a void, which sooner or later will annihilate it.

Co-ordination is therefore one of the main factors of a harmonious force which completes the incomplete laws, and ameliorates the life of a nation, which badly needs people who possess not only an active intellect but a soul to match it, who are aware of the burdens of their fellow-men and take steps to relieve them of the bitter truth of oppression.

I speak to all, in a broad and not in a narrow sense. You have examples of great and powerful Nations, where, because of had co-ordination, the desired harmony does not exist. In this manner these Nations go towards their own unlooked-for but certain destruction. Truth gives the lie to the false words of bad leaders.

The inexhaustible wealth of a Nation is a cheat. Everything comes to an end when there is no co-ordination and harmony. All is annihilated when the Spirit of Evil enters the minds of the corrupt and worthless men of your Earth. Such men exist not only in the West but in the East. All these forces of Evil will be destroyed in all ways because the peoples desire and embrace only what is beneficial in man, not what is harmful and worthless.

Co-ordination and Harmony are brothers and live in the same house as Love: that is, in the house of Peace.

# The Path of Life

## *Teaching 57th*

In speaking of the "Path of Life", I am not referring to life on Earth, which is short and whose purpose it is to prepare the human being for a better existence. There are also Teachers of the opposite faction, who receive their miracle-working powers from the Evil Demons. That is why the Spiritual World emphasises that you should not pay attention to the miracles worked by human beings, but only to the pure Divine Word which governs all things with such justice and harmony that you do not perceive its workings.

A path means a way which is difficult to traverse. The balanced spirit which possesses psychic fortitude is able, even on Earth, to traverse this path in ecstasy and to reach a certain level of Heaven, in order that he may tell his fellow-men something about the Heavenly Life. Therefore, all who make excuses about the Unknown, saying that none of the dead has ever returned to enlighten us, are not only blind but deaf. There are many living who are transported to the life beyond Earth and who return to enlighten their brothers about eternity and the different spheres of our own prevailing Kingdom.

If a dead man came back to life and spoke to men about the Heavenly Kingdom, would he be believed? Why then do they not believe the living Teachers, who possess equilibrium and spiritual authority, when they talk about what they saw through the third eye and what they have learned from Spirits who rank high in the Kingdom of the Lord?

Those who do not believe in the righteous and reasonable instructions or Teachings of Heaven will find their antidote at the various stages of eternal life, and will weep bitterly in the course of their healing.

# The importance of Moderation

## *Teaching 75th*

Moderation is the basis of human life.

Moderation is not unjust, does not abuse, and does not hate.

Moderation is the love of balance.

The saying "Moderation in all things" was not a manner of speaking but a true revelation of the Divine light to men of spirituality and reason.

Poetry without measure has no harmony and music deprived of measure sounds wrongly. You ought therefore to possess moderation as a yardstick for everything.

The frenzied imagination has no moderation, only madness.

Insistence on an idea or on a mistaken tradition leads to fanaticism, which compels man to backtrack from the right path and changes him from a calm person to a crazy detractor of the truth and an enemy of love.

Do not ignore moderation. Everything done in moderation is correct; beyond that you create chasms which lead you to the irredeemable abyss.

The value of moderation is a priceless treasure for man.

When you act according to a double standard, it is called "deceit" and is punished by Divinity. You are using the word "standard", (or measure) but in a different, deceitful sense. That is, you are cheating your brothers through this flexible standard and ignoring your conscience, which carries all the burden of your evil deeds, so as to point out the mistakes to your spirit in the Tribunal.

The burden of the spirit is carried by the soul (the conscience) and it is relieved of it in the Heavens, because it shifts the burden onto the shoulders of the spirit which, unable to rid itself of the pressure, suffers unimaginably.

It is your sacred duty to act well and virtuously, but not beyond the bounds of moderation, for men will reward you with ingratitude instead of gratitude, and the torment of your spirit will be doubled. Great kindness exhausts your goodness and strengthens the evil spirit of human rebellion.

You give your enemy a helping hand. To a certain degree you do well. Further than that you encourage his wickedness not only towards yourself, his helper, but towards his brothers as well.

An evil person will say: "I am only able to impose myself on my adversary and make him afraid of me in my own fashion".

In order that such people, who are capable of harming many of their brothers, do not take advantage of you, do not fail to carry moderation with you wherever you go.

The absolute does not exist on Earth, nor amongst the lower ranks of souls in Heaven. The absolute is Utopia, a word which for the naive possesses a deceptive attraction. The absolute, as a quality of the Good and the Virtuous, transmits its energy in small doses to people of moderation.

It is truly lamentable that man does not understand Divine Knowledge, which is transmitted for his benefit. We do our duty; if some of you want to ignore the extent of Divine Goodness, it is their own evil doing.

People who lack moderation are led by evil spirits, and who knows where they might end up, so as to be punished as they deserve.

Moderation is the harmony of life, as are the successive forces of nature. Moderation harmonizes life both spiritually and in the soul.

Moderation contains the passions and determines what is correct. It lends charm to music and preserves the beauty of feminine attraction.

# Telepathic communication

## *Teaching 160th*

There are many categories of telepathic communication, of which the main ones are as follows:

- 1) intuitive
- 2) visionary
- 3) prescriptive
- 4) current

1. Intuitive telepathy. This is when we sense the event, whether good or bad, which is taking place at that moment or is about to do so. For example, you feel that something bad is happening to A or B, or that something is about to happen to him, and you feel some kind of weight on your soul. This occurs because the person in question is thinking about you. Thus one person is the transmitter and the other the receiver of a particular state.

When it is a question of something pleasant it is seldom transmitted because the person who is feeling the happiness is both astonished and overjoyed, without thinking at that moment about anyone close to him or an acquaintance or a friend. This is why, for the most part, telepathic communications or presentiments always transmit misfortune and grief. When he is satisfied with life man, as usual, thinks of nobody, because he is enjoying the moment. In his grief, however, he reflects on people and things which remind him in some way of times past.

2. Visionary telepathy. This occurs in the same way as the above, the difference between them being that in this case you see the events in vision. You see an entire scene reflected from the optic nerve of A or B. That is to say, you see only the scene that A or B sees. If they murder, rob or arrest A or B, the receiver sees the scene in detail, but not the continuation of it, because the transmitter has ceased functioning.

3. Prescriptive telepathy. In this case, the images that you see for a second or longer are images of something that will occur in the future. The subconscious of A or of B, which is acquainted with the entire course of his life, transmits the images to those who are closest to A or B, without his being aware of what his subconscious is transmitting.

It often happens that you see, in vision or in sleep, a place or a person or something else which you never knew; and after a time you wonder where you came across them (that is, of course, if you do not remember your vision).

4. Current telepathy. This is called "instantaneous telepathy", because as the image takes place, transmission and reception occur simultaneously. This is the most usual form of telepathy. One person might be at the South Pole and the other at the North Pole, and be able to communicate by this means.

Man contains within himself many potentialities of which he is ignorant and which he does not bother to develop even if it is pointed out to him that he is a good medium or the possessor of ectoplasmic qualities and so on. Every man has a gift which, sadly, he does not know about. There are people - in this case very few indeed - who can see into the bowels of the earth and can tell you what the Earth contains in its depths.

God was never unjust to anyone; it is you who are not in a position to find out what kind of a gift you have received from Him. When you turn to the Spiritual World and believe in it, many things will be revealed to you.

# Understanding, rational thought and perception on Goodness and Virtue

## *Teaching 194th*

Hither-to you have learned a good many things which you did not know from the Spiritual World. Through the truth of its Word, this World is continually illumining mankind, showing man the right path to follow on Earth, that he may also follow it in Heaven.

When the dying man forsakes his material envelope, it is not so as to enter the World of Souls with open arms, there to find peace of spirit and the immeasurable love of the Spiritual World. You are deceived! The dying man does not pass, on the recommendation of the priest, to a green, peaceful, paradisaal place.

The dying man should consider what he has done in his life, so as to take up an equivalent position in the Kingdom of the Lord.

As I have emphasized elsewhere, God does not punish like man, using injustice as his measure, and thereby proving that he too bears the seeds of evil within him. God punishes without compulsion. If, of course, a being does not fall subject to the Darkness, the terrible pangs of conscience can utterly reduce it, until it comprehends its unjust actions and voluntarily endures its intolerable burden until it acquires greater psychic fortitude, and receives new instructions from the Lord.

None of you think about death until you are on the brink of it, when it is too late for repentance. The priest, of course, being a professional in his field, grants you remission of sins; but of whom did he ask permission to perform this arbitrary act?

If you pay him five times more than he usually gets, he may even class you along with the Angels! Tell me in all frankness, do they not deceive you even at the final moment of your departure from this Earth?

If, given your present spiritual level, you do not improve your minds and are illuminated not just by earthly knowledge but by Heavenly as well, your life on this Earth will have been in vain.

Try to acquire an understanding of life and to think rationally about it, that you may be capable of discerning what is good and virtuous in it. If you cannot distinguish these, it means that you have no idea of Love; and to him who does not feel love for his neighbour, harm and evil in all their forms will inevitably appear as goodness and virtue!

Ponder and study Goodness alone. If this study becomes a habit, it will aid you greatly in rejecting all evil acts.

Every so often prune back your egotism, for it is a parasite on your being. It thrives wherever it can dominate the spirit. If you have the willpower, take note of its growth and be quick to prevent it.

Through understanding of the Divine Word, through rational thought and human perception, you acquire the divine weapons of Goodness and Virtue, and you are able to participate in the open warfare of the Spiritual World against the cruel Prince of Darkness
